

CANNAS

BACKGROUND: Cannas are native to Central and South America but have been hybridized in Europe. Cannas are "rhizome" bulbs and are considered the EASIEST of all bulbs to grow. Their tropical-looking foliage (resembling miniature banana leaves) is enhanced by 4"-5" showy flower spikes that come in a myriad of colors. Cannas provide brilliant splashes of color in the extreme heat of the summer because of their extreme vigor. Cannas start blooming the first warm days of spring and will bloom 'til frost. Cannas will grow from 2' to 7' tall, depending on variety. Pfitzer cannas developed in Germany seldom exceed 3 feet and can be grown in patio tubs.

PLANTING: Cannas prefer a rich, moist soil but will accept a poor soil. Plant in spring on one foot spacing in full sun or light shade. Work in a generous amount of **Nature Life Composted Cotton Burrs** in bed prior to planting. Only cover bulb 1"-2" after planting. Stake tall varieties.

FEEDING: Feed Cannas once or twice a month depending on how good the soil is with **Fertilome Gardener's Special**, low in nitrogen but high in phosphorus & potash. Be generous with water in summer heat.

PRUNING: As soon as a flower spike has finished blooming, remove it and a new one will take its place. Old flowers sap plant's strength.
