

How to Care for Your **POTTED ROSE PLANT**

A bright light location is preferred. Roses need full sunlight for best flowering.

Moderately moist soil is preferred. Water thoroughly when soil surface feels dry. Drain excess water in saucer to prevent root rot and protect furniture.

Warm temperatures are ideal: 70-75°F (21-24°C) daytimes and 65-70°F (18-21°C) nights. Higher humidity is preferred.

FERTILIZE TIP FOR SUCCESS: Roses are excellent summer pot plants for outdoors as well as indoors. These roses are very hardy in the Lubbock area & bloom all summer if planted outside.
